Friends & Neighbors,

Some of you may already be aware that our President, Katherine Call, resigned from the Board effective April 1, 2023, sold her home, and is moving back to North Carolina to be with family and old friends. We wish her the best of luck in her new life adventure.

Your Acting President will be Susan Seger. Susan's letter introducing herself is attached. The duties of Acting Treasurer, which were being performed by Katherine, are now the responsibility of Kathy Kennedy. She volunteered to fulfill the obligations of acting Treasurer that involve the financial aspects of our Association that cannot be passed on to outside third parties.

There is still a community-wide misunderstanding regarding maintenance of the trees and vegetation between the buildings. Any trees and other vegetation that straddle the shared boundary line are shared. Each Owner is responsible for maintaining and cleaning up what is within, or falls on, their property.

We want to remind Owners & residents that **THERE IS NO DESIGNATED AREA WITHIN THE COMMUNITY FOR DISPOSING OF YARD DEBRIS.** Yard debris is not to be put out in common areas assuming that it is the responsibility of the Association. Occasionally a large pile of tree debris will appear in a common area that is not next to Cheney Highway. These are the result of our maintenance contractor trimming trees within the common area. This is usually done before hurricane season. The solid waste division of the City of Titusville is called in advance of the creation of such a pile because it can take weeks for the City to send their truck for pick up. **The City will not pick up yard debris placed in the common areas between our property and Cheney Highway.**

Due to sparse activity on the HOA Hotline phone the Board made the decision to cancel this service. Instead, you will contact your building's Director, shown below with questions. **ALL ISSUES REGARDING THE IRRIGATION/SPRINKLER SYSTEM, ARE TO BE REPORTED TO SUSAN SEGER AT 803-272-5321. SHE WILL NOTIFY MAINTENANCE CONTRACTOR OF ISSUE FOR RESOLUTION.**
